And this unique occasion is used to felicitate the winners in different outside competitions and students' participation in seminars, presentation of papers etc. to motivate other students.

The context

After declaration of final year results of B.A, B.Com, B.B.A and B.Sc., the class teachers of respective program make result analysis. The S.W.O makes the list of top scorers as per the decided criteria for award of gold medal and cash prizes. The criteria are --

1. Cash prize of Rs. 1000.00 to every student who secures 80% to 85% in aggregate at B.A, B.Com, B.B.A & B.Sc. Degree Examinations.
2. Gold Medal to every student who secures above 85% of marks in aggregate at B.A, B.Com, B.B.A & B.Sc. Degree Examinations.

The SWO organizes a special function called 'Pratibha Purashkar' by inviting the scholars and academicians. Such students along with students securing distinction marks, are formally felicitated at this function. Specially, the Gold Medalist and Cash Prize Winners are again invited to attend the annual day to receive their Gold medal and cash prizes.
